



Scatter around ornamental trees where browsing of lower branches or damage to bark is noticed Cardboard cartons containing Repel = 2, with holes punched in upper sides, may be hung from branches of trees or fastened to tree trunks and fances.

Raccoons: Treat areas around vegetable gardens (not within), garbage cans and other places where raccoon damage occurs. Apply at the rate of 1 ib per 55 sq, feet and repeat once a week until no further damage occurs. Raccoons will often nest in nooks and crannies around farm build ings. When a nest is found, place a cardboard container containing Repet =2, with holes punched in upper sides, as close to the nest as possible.
