Your faxed letters of March 23 an 28, 1996

In the above letters, you requested a change in the grade of Castor Oil in these products and changes in your precautionary statement and use directions. The comments are as follows:

A. Change in Grade of Castor Oil

Originally, this product did not contain Castor Oil. Subsequently, we took the unusual step of allowing you to add this active ingredient to your product without requiring a new product number or requiring a new battery of six basic acute toxicity tests. The reason that we allowed the change to your existing products was that you agreed to use a USP Grade of Castor Oil, the same grade used as medicine and about which we did not have toxicity concerns. To allow a change to a lower grade of Castor Oil, one not used as a medicine, would violate the original basis for allowing the addition of Castor Oil in these products without additional data.

Although the specification sheets cited identical toxicity data for both grades of Castor Oil, the sheets did not indicate which grade was tested or contain the actual studies. We would have to review these data cited in the specification sheets before making a decision about changing the grade of the Castor Oil. The only other option is repeating the toxicity studies on your proposed formula with the lower grade of Castor Oil.

Since a principal reason for wanting the lower grade of Castor Oil is its availability in 5 gallon containers, perhaps you could work out something with your supplier to obtain the USP grade in such containers.

B. Change in the Precautionary Labeling

Since the product is in Toxicity II for eye irritation, you are concerned about the statement, "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury." You are concerned that the statement might frighten consumers. As a substitute, you suggested "Avoid getting in eyes which will cause temporary eye injury."

Basically, all of our toxicity statements use standard language, depending on the route of exposure and toxicity. All products in Category II for eye irritation would use the same statement as found on your product. Therefore, you would not be at a competitive disadvantage for other products having the same toxicity for eye.

We cannot change the text of this statement for your product unless we decided to change the text for all products.

C. Change in Use Directions

In the past, the label directions had specified certain rates of coverage (such as 11b per 55 or 110 sq. ft., depending on the species). You wanted to drop these rates and just direct users "to sprinkle in a zigzag line the width of a garden hose" for two reasons.

- 1. You felt that expressing rates in terms of pound per sq. ft. was not very relevant to the household consumer.
- 2. You felt that your product would be at a competitive disadvantage if another product claimed higher coverage.

We have no objection to this change. However, since the rate for cats was double that for dogs, your revised directions should reflect this higher rate. In addition, as you gather effectiveness data in the future, you must still record rates in pounds 1) per sq. ft. or 2) per linear band of a specific width so that meaningful use directions can be developed for users.

We received a complete revised label for EPA Reg. No. 20215-6 but not for EPA Reg. No. 20215-7.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that

you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before your ship product:

1. Revise your dog and cat directions as follows:

DOGS: Remove all fecal matter present in area to be treated. Sprinkle STOP IT! in 1 inch zigzag lines, about 2 feet apart, over the area to be treated.

CATS: Remove all fecal matter present in area to be treated. Sprinkle <u>STOP IT!</u> in 2 inch zigzag lines, about 2 feet apart, over the area to be treated.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

D. Effectiveness Data in Support of Products

As indicated in our January 1995 letter, data submitted to support product effectiveness were not adequate to support the claims being made for this product. Therefore, you will need to ensure that you have in your files efficacy data consistent with the EPA Guidelines to support the uses on your label: dogs and cats. Since the Agency considers all of the pests to be non-public health uses, you do not need to submit these data to the Agency for review at the present time. However, we could call-in these data in the future if we received complaints or data showing ineffectiveness or if you proposed greatly elevated rates. In addition, if you failed to have such data on file to support your product claims, your product could be subject to enforcement action.


