FOR SWIMMING POOLS FOR CONTROL OF ALGAE

Pride Algaecide is compatible with all chemicals used for treating swimming pool water. It works best in slightly alkaline water having a PH of between 7.2 and 7.8. Pride Algaecide is simply poured into the water from any point.

It quickly distributes itself throughout the entire pool. In pools equipped with a circulating system it may also be aided through the filter.

DIRECTIONS

FOR INITIAL TREATMENT UPON FILLING POOLS, USE
 One gallon for each 36,000 gallons of water
 One quart for each 9,000 gallons of water
 One cup for each 2,250 gallons of water

FOR SUBSEQUENT TREATMENT USE
 One quart for each 18,000 gallons of water
 One cup for each 5,000 gallons of water

SUBSEQUENT TREATMENTS should be given once every five days. If high temperatures prevail, or if pool has unusually use, add additional dosage as warranted.

WARNING

Do not get in eyes, or on skin or on clothes. Use mask or face shield when handling. Causes severe eye damage and skin irritation. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID

If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of fluids and call a physician immediately.
