DIRECTIONS

HOW MUCH TO USE

WHEN ALGAE IS NOT VISIBLE: In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth and for maintenance dosage, add **HY-GUARD "50"** according to the maintenance chart below.

POOL CAPACITY	MAINTENANCE DOSAGE ADD EVERY 5 TO 7 DAYS
760 gal.	2 oz.
1,520 gal.	4 oz.
2,120 gal.	8 oz.
3,240 gal.	16 oz.
12,480 gal.	1 qt.
24,960 gal.	2 gal.

WHEN ALGAE IS VISIBLE: If algae growth is visible, add 1 1/2 gallons **HY-GUARD "50"** per 12,500 gallons of water to kill and control algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. If algae growth is just visible, the initial dose must be 1 1/2 gallons per 12,500 gallons, followed by cleaning out settled algae and applying **HY-GUARD "50"** as stated in maintenance dosage.

IF WARM WEATHER prevails or pool has unusually heavy use, maintenance dosage may have to be repeated more frequently.

HOW TO USE

Measure stated amount of **HY-GUARD "50"** into a bucket of water and distribute evenly throughout pool water.

HY-GUARD "50"

WARNING
