It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **APPLICATION SITES:** For use in treatment of fire ant mounds in residential, institutional, commercial, and recreational areas. Not for application to law-producing areas.

HOW TO APPLY: One pouch is sufficient to treat one average size mound. Use scissors to open outer pouch along indicated line. Allow the unopened inner pouch to drop into one gallon of water in a sprinkler can. Stir until powder is uniformly dispersed. Apply 1 gallon of solution as a gentle rain to each fire ant mound. If mound diameter is greater than 22 inches, treat with 2 gallons of water containing two pouches of product. Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding areas to a 4 ft. diameter (125 sq. ft.). Results apply in cool weather (65°-85° F) or in early morning or late evening. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Large quantities of solution can be prepared for multiple mound treatment. Equipment to deliver the diluted product as a gentle rain at the rate of 1 cfm per mound is still required. Pressurized sprays may disturb the ants and cause injury, reducing product effectiveness.

Allow the unopened inner packet to drop into one gallon of water in a sprinker can. Stir until powder is uniformly dispersed. Apply 1 gallon of solution as a gentle rain to each fire ant mound. If mound diameter is greater than 22 inches, treat with 2 gallons of water containing two pouches of product. Thoroughly wet mound and surrounding areas to a 4 ft. diameter (125 sq. ft.). For best results, apply in cool weather (65° - 80° F.) or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.
