WHEN TO USE

Scotch Gardener Lawn Weed & Feed should be used anytime weeds are actively growing. Hormone like weed killers are most effective when daytime temperatures are above 60° F. Do not use on newly planted lawns until after third mowing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Use only on grass lawns: (Kentucky Bluegrass, Bermudagrass, Fescue, Ryegrass).
2. Water lawn thoroughly before treatment. Do not water or mow lawn for at least two days after treatment - then resume normal watering.
3. Apply to lawn at recommended rate when lawn is damp (after rain, sprinkling or dew) so pellets will stick to weeds.
4. Avoid drift to or contact with desirable plants. Do not apply within dripline of trees and shrubs.
5. Do not exceed recommended rate of application which is 4 lbs. per 1,000 square feet (20' x 50').

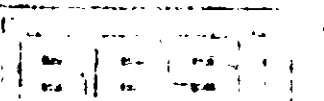
