STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

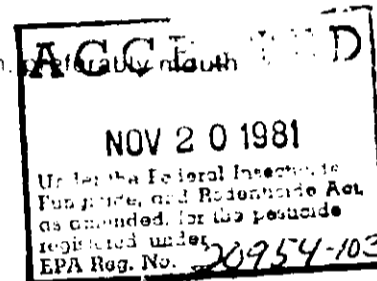
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth.

IF IN EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes.

Get medical attention if irritation persists.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS

May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. May cause eye irritation. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor.
