LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE, OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:

IN SOAKING SUDS: Add 1/2 tablespoon of this product for each gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry for 11 minutes to overnight. Wash. Rinse. **IN WASHING SUDS:** Add 1/2 tablespoon of this product for each gallon water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. (For automatic washers into which laundry is placed before water is added, dilute recommended amount of this product in a quart of water and pour into washer after laundry is immersed.)

BLEACH, DISINFECTANT, STAIN REMOVER OR CLEANSER:

To remove STAINS-Fruit, Berry, Wine, Coffee, Tea, Chocolate, Vegetable, Flour, Grass, Blood, and many ink, Dye and Medicine Stains, also Scorch and Mildew. Do not use on silk, wool, or unfast colors. Make solution 1/2 tablespoon of this product for each quart of cold water. Mix thoroughly. Immerse fabric five to ten minutes. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Any trace of mildew remaining usually disappears when fabric is dried in sunlight.

NET CONTENTS: 5 Gallons (18.9 Liters)

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

DAIRIES AND CREAMERIES:

To help keep down bacteria count and to help tenderize utensils and equipment with a chlorine solution follow U.S. Public Health Department's instructions.

RESTAURANTS-FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES, AND SILVERWARE: Remove large food particles by scraping before sanitizing. Utensils should be soaked for 60 seconds or sprayed to wet all surfaces for 10-15 minutes from available chlorine solution of 100 ppm.

100 ppm available chlorine solution is 1/2 tablespoon of this product to 4 gallons of water. Rinse with potable water before reuse.

IMPORTANT: Follow Directions with Care. Basic measurements: 1 teaspoon 1/2 oz. BON CHLOR 1 gallon of water equals 200 parts per million (ppm) available chlorine. 8 oz. equals one cup.
