HOW MUCH TO USE:
WHEN ALGAE IS NOT VISIBLE. In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth, add 16 oz. H Y - G U A R D "400" per 12,500 gallons of water. **WHEN ALGAE IS VISIBLE.** If algae growth is visible, add 32 oz. H Y - G U A R D "400" per 12,500 gallons of water to kill and control algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. As soon as algae is dead and has withered, vacuum and clean the pool.

MAINTENANCE DOSAGE
 Add 8 oz. H Y - G U A R D "400" every 5-7 days per 12,500 gallons of water. If warm weather prevails or pool has unusually heavy use, maintenance dosage may have to be repeated more frequently.

HOW TO USE
 Mix required amount of H Y - G U A R D "400" into a bucket of water and distribute evenly throughout pool water.

HY-GUARD "400"

DANGER:
