### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

Hold container upright, nozzle away from you and press actuator button up as directed.

**TO TREAT ANIMALS:** To protect animals from attacks of stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, horn flies, quilloes and gnats, spray about 30 seconds on each side being careful to spray legs, belly, neck, back, and face. Cover eyes while spraying face, or use sponge or cloth and apply to face with sponge. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome. Breathing apparatus on animal after applying will bring bright sheen.

**TO KILL AND REPEL FLYING INSECTS:** Spray in areas where insects congregate. Direct spray to contact insects for knockdown and kill. Spray around perimeter of door facings, screens to areas unattractive to insects. This helps repel insects and prevent entrance into building.

**TO CONTROL COCKROACHES AND ANTS:** To control cockroaches and ants, spray into cracks and crevices, directly on cockroaches for fast kill behind refrigerator, stove and cabinets where insects tend to hide.

**TO CONTROL TICKS, FLEAS AND CHIGGERS:** Spray on animal until moistened lightly. To ensure thorough coverage part the fur by stroking in the lay of the hair while spraying. If ticks are tough, spray directly on them. Repeat every few days until animal is free of ticks, nits, or eggs that hatch.
