#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **Use Restrictions**

- Except when applying directly to animals, do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried or vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Cover eyes while spraying face or spray on sponge or cloth and apply to face as a wipe. Brushing horse after applying will bring out a bright sheen.

TO KILL AND REPEL FLYING INSECTS IN ANIMAL QUARTERS: Spray in areas where insects congregate at a rate of 1 second per square foot. Direct spray to contact insects for rapid knockdown and kill. Spray around door facings and screens to render area unattractive to insects. This helps to repel insects and prevent entrance into building.
