The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrin and PBO RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

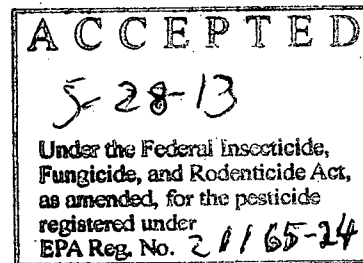

Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to produce runoff that contains this product.

CONTROLS

For use as a space spray in overhead systems to control house flies, horse flies, stable flies, deer flies, gnats, mosquitoes, fleas, ticks, ants, roaches.

USE

Can be used in horse barns, kennels, dairy barns, milking parlors, milk rooms, show arenas, breeding areas, poultry houses, swine parlors, meat packing plants, supermarket receiving areas, food processing plants, warehouses, bottling plants, flour mills, grain elevators. Also for use around homes for insect control on patios, tennis courts, pool areas, beach houses.

APPLICATION

Dilute before using. Use clean water. Add concentrate to water and mix well. Locate nozzles to cover maximum of 2000 cubic feet space.

DILUTION

0.1% Pyrethrin – Add 1 part concentrate to 29 parts water.

0.075% Pyrethrin – Add 1 part concentrate to 39 parts water.

0.067% Pyrethrin – Add 1 part concentrate to 44 parts water.

0.05% Pyrethrin – Add 1 part concentrate to 59 parts water.

Directions for use in animal premise automatic misting systems:

Do not place nozzles directly over or within 8 feet of exposed feeds, dishes, milking utensils and feed handling or preparation areas.

Do not install within 3 feet of air vents.

Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and recharging with pesticide or conducting maintenance.

Do not apply when food, feed and/or water is present. Remove or cover exposed food and water before application.

When used in dairy barns or facilities, close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking.

When using this product, installers and service technicians must comply with the license, certification or registration requirements of the state(s), tribe(s) or local authority(ies) where they are installed.

- 0.1% pyrethrin – 7.3 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.075% pyrethrins – 9.75 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.067% pyrethrins – 10.9 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.05% pyrethrins – 14.6 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day

Directions for use in outdoor residential misting systems:

[NOTE: Not registered for use in Residential Automatic Mosquito Misting Systems in the State of New York.]

Do not make applications during rain.

Cover or remove food and drinking water before application.

Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces of wash them before use.

When using this product installers and service technicians must comply with the license, certification or registration requirements of the state(s), tribe(s) or local authority(ies) where they are installed.

If the system works on an automatic timer, set the timing for application when people, pets and food are unlikely to be present.

If the system works when a person operates a remote activation device, then application of this pesticide when people, pets and food are present is prohibited.

Do not use in a evaporative cooling system.

Direct nozzles to spray towards the target area and away from swimming pools, water bodies or eating and cooking areas.

Do not set nozzles to direct mist near outside air condition systems or other home air intakes.

If used in a system with a reservoir tank for the end use dilution, the system reservoir tank must be locked. Securely attach the end use pesticide label and a dilution statement to the system reservoir tank in a weather protected area or plastic sleeve. Contact the system manufacturer for guidance or assistance to ensure compliance with the following requirement:

This product must only be used in systems that have been calibrated to apply no more than the maximum application rate of 0.00011 lbs pyrethrins and 0.00058 lbs piperonyl butoxide per 1000 cubic feet per day. This is equivalent to:

- 0.1% pyrethrin – 0.9 ounce of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.075% pyrethrins – 1.2 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.067% pyrethrins – 1.33 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day
- 0.05% pyrethrins – 1.8 ounces of diluted product per 1000 cubic feet per day

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available, or reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures as approved by state and local authorities.
