The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The revise wording to be as follows, "**Kills Deer Ticks That May Carry Lyme Disease.**"
2. It has come to our attention the product name **Pyranha Insecticide Household Formulation** is currently used on two registered products, EPA Reg. No. 21165-25 and EPA Reg. No. 21165-28. Each product should carry a distinct product name. Please clarify with product will be identified by the above name.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

SHAKE

For spot application, use space spray. Do not use on electrical equipment. Avoid shock hazard.

TO CONTROL: To control roaches and crickets, spray in cracks and crevices, under the stove, and in the

TO KILL: Spray in a direct spray down and kill on facings, screens, and insects through entrance into

TO CONTROL: GERS. Spray lightly. To eliminate by stroke spraying. Repeat them. Repeat in 10 days or eggs.

TO CONTROL: home vacuum those pet animals and breed flea and tick days. Re-treat
