Pyranha Flea and Tick Repellent With Pyrethrin
EPA Registration No. 21165-28
Your letter dated March 13, 1991

The labeling referred above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Delete the claim ". . . is less frightening to pet." This implies comparison with other pesticide products and is not allowed.
2. Delete the claim "It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays and, therefore, less frightening to your pet."
3. "Sergeant's Flea & Tick Spray. . ." should read "Pyranha Flea & Tick Spray . . ."
4. See comment number one in our letter dated January 16, 1991.
