

For best results close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Remove animals before application. Vacate the treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary but not more often than once every 2 weeks.

3. Please make the following changes in the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF):

- b. Please provide the upper and lower certified limit for the deionized water added as an inert solvent in the formulation process.
- c. If the flashpoint of the product is greater than 150 degrees F, please indicate "> 150 °F" in the CSF and in the product-specific data matrix.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

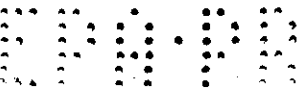

USE

For use in horse barns, kennels, dairy barns, milking parlors, milk rooms, poultry houses, mink houses, zoo animal quarters, cattle feed lots, hog confinements areas.

Use as a space spray to control house flies, stable flies, horse flies, fruit flies, deer flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

DILUTION

Dilute before using. Use clean water. Add concentrate to water and mix well.

When used as a space spray to control flying insects, dilute by adding one (1) part concentrate to eleven (11) parts water.
