Subject: Amendment- drop and add sites
Pyranha Space Spray 1-10 HP Concentrate
EPA Registration No. 21165-32
Your Submission dated January 5, 1998

This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Revise second sentence under Dilution/ Use Rate to read: "When used as a space spray and ultra low volume spray dilute by adding xxx etc."

b. Revise front panel statement to read "For Commercial/ Industrial Use Only".

c. On side panel revise the second paragraph to read, "Use as an outdoor area spray for temporary reduction of listed insects on and around home xxx etc."

d. Following the second sentence of the second paragraph under Application Directions add the following: "Direct the diluted spray into tall grass, shrubbery and around lawns where these pests may hover or rest. Apply when the air is still and avoid wetting foliage. Do not apply when wind speeds exceed 10 mph. Do not apply directly to open water. Do not apply within 100 feet of lakes and streams. Do not allow spray treatment to drift on ornamental ponds, pasture lands, cropland, poultry ranges, or water supplies. Repeat treatment as necessary xxx etc."

e. Add the following bee precaution under Enviromental Hazards: "This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area."

f. Revise the first sentence under Enviromental Hazards to read: This product is highly toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms."

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
