

CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STOP: READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE. DO NOT USE ON DOGS OR CATS OR OTHER ANIMALS OTHER THAN HORSES. DO NOT USE ON HORSES INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION. DO NOT USE ON FOALS UNDER THREE (3) MONTHS OF AGE.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.

{BACK/SIDE LABEL PANEL CON'T.}

FOR USE ON HORSES. USE FULL STRENGTH: This non-oily insecticide/repellent may be applied with a spray application or as a wipe. Kills and repels horse flies, stable flies, horn flies, house flies, face flies, deer flies, bot flies, mosquitoes, fleas, gnats, lice and ticks.

DIRECTIONS FOR WIPE-ON USE: Thoroughly brush horse to remove excess dirt and dust. Extremely dirty horses should be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry before applying wipe. Use a sponge or clean soft cloth or mitt. Apply liberally over areas to be protected. Pay special attention to legs, belly, shoulders, neck and facial areas. Avoid eyes and mucous membrane.

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DIRECTIONS FOR SPRAY USE: Remove excess dirt and dust. Apply light spray mist to coat while brushing lightly against lay of the hair. Avoid spray in eyes and mucous membranes. Apply with sponge or soft cloth to those areas. Reapply in 10-14 days or as needed to maintain control. Reapply after animal is washed, has had excessive sweating or if exposed to heavy rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Disposal: If empty: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
