The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. #### Restrictions:

- Apply only as specified on this label.
- Except when applying directly to animals, do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Except when applying directly to animals, do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets either directly or through drift.
- Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.
- Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR WIPE-ON USE: Thoroughly brush horse to remove excess dirt and dust. Extremely dirty horses should be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry before applying wipe. Use a sponge or clean soft cloth or mitt. Apply liberally (1- 2 ounces) over areas to be protected. Pay special attention to legs, belly, shoulders, neck and facial areas. Avoid eyes and mucous membranes. Reapply in 10-14 days or as needed to maintain control. Reapply after animal is washed, has had excessive sweating or if exposed to heavy rain.

DIRECTIONS FOR SPRAY USE: Remove excess dirt and dust. Apply 1-2 ounces as a light spray mist to coat while brushing lightly against lay of the hair. Avoid spray in eyes and mucous membranes. Apply with sponge or soft cloth to those areas. Reapply in 10-14 days or as needed to maintain control. Reapply after animal is washed, has had excessive sweating or if exposed to heavy rain.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste Agency for local disposal options.

**Container Handling:** If empty: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

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Shake Well Before Use.

FOR USE ON HORSES: Clean horse's face, ears and other areas to be treated by brushing or with a soft damp cloth. Remove cap from bottle. Apply around animal's nose, eyes, ears and mouth. May also be used as a spot treatment where flies gather. Avoid direct application to eyes, nose and mouth. Replace cap after use. For initial treatment, apply daily for 2 to 3 days. Then apply every 10-14 days as needed to maintain control. Do not use more than 1-2 ounces per application.
