This non-oily insecticide is applied to the horse with a trigger spray nozzle. It kills and repels horse flies, house flies, face flies, mosquitoes, fleas, and ticks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
Brush horse to remove dirt and grease. Use extremely dirty horses. Rinse and allow to dry. Use a sponge or brush to apply Equine Formula to the horse's body, protected. Pay particular attention to shoulders, neck, and mucous membranes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
Remove excess spray mist to coat white areas of the horse's hair. Avoid spraying the horse's face. Apply with sponge.

TO KILL AND REPEL:
Apply to areas where insects are most likely to contact insects. Spray around or over the horse to render area unattractive and repel insects and ticks.
