- e. Delete "aqueous" from the product name and all other references to this product as "water-based," for example "This is a water based insecticide . . . Will not damage surfaces that are not affected by water" and "Do not store this water-based formulation" The level of water and petroleum solvent contained in this product does not justify such statements.
- f. Add a statement requiring use of protective gloves or mitt to the directions for use.
- g. The statement should read "Do not incinerate or puncture."

3. Please provide the flashpoint of the product with propellant for the Confidential Statement Formula and the flashpoint/flame extension of the product for the data matrix. The flashpoint reported exceeds the one expected for the product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR 156.10(h)(2)(iii). (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.)

4. Please submit a storage stability study for this product. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in the trade. Note: For the storage stability study, you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate your product.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
