1. The statement "Use protective gloves (mitts) to prevent contact with hands." should appear under the Directions for Use.
2. The statement is simply "FLAMMABLE", not "This product is FLAMMABLE."

The flame extension and storage stability data submitted are acceptable and have been made a part of the record for this product. However, with respect to the storage stability data, please provide the temperature and type of container used in the study.
