**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold container upright and spray from top and bottom as directed.

Use protective gloves to avoid contact with hands.

**USE**

**TO CONTROL TICKS AND CHIGGERS:** Spray and allow to dry. If the animal is moistened lightly, spray for thorough coverage part by part against the lay of the hair. Ring ticks are tough to kill. Repeat every 2-3 days until animal is free of insects. Do not re-hatch.

**TO PROTECT ANIMALS:** Spray ticks, fleas and mosquitoes about 3 seconds on each leg, head and sides. Cover eyes and face or spray on cloth as a wipe. Repeat as necessary when pet returns from outdoors.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Use protective gloves (mitts) to prevent contact with hands. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD: FLAMMABLE**

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container in fire or incinerator.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or poison control center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
