USE

FOR USE ON HORSES, USE FULL STRENGTH. This non-oily insecticide is applied with a trigger spray applicator, or as a wipe. Kills and repels house flies, horse flies, ear flies, bot flies, mosquitoes, fleas, and ticks.

DIRECTIONS FOR WIPE-ON USE: Thoroughly wash horse's face. Use a sponge or clean soft cloth or rag. Apply liberally over areas of concern to legs, belly, shoulders, neck, and facial areas. Avoid eyes.

DIRECTIONS FOR TRIGGER SPRAY USE: Remove excess dirt and dandruff while brushing lightly against lay of the hair. Avoid spray in eyes.

Apply with sponge or soft cloth to those areas. Reapply in 10-14 days after animal is washed or if exposed to heavy rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container
