Wipe N' Spray Insecticide is developed for use as protective hair coating a high sheen to 4 ounces per head protection. Apply by either

DIRECTION

First, brush animal hair. Moisten (but do not wet) soft cloth and rub over rubbing against the hair. Attention to the legs, facial areas where necessary. Only a light application. Excessive amount will irritate skin. After application, brush bright sheen on the hair. Repeat daily or as

DIRECTIONS FOR

Remove excess dust with mist to coat while brushing hair. Avoid spray in eyes. Apply with sponge. Do not wet horse's skin. application.

TO KILL AND REPEL

ANIMAL QUARTERS. Insects congregate in corners for rapid knockdown. Apply to door facings, screens to insects. This helps prevent entrance into buildings.
