1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 21165-50".
- b. Add the following precautionary statements to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

"May cause eye irritation" and "Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

- c. Since your data does not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the Physical and Chemical Hazards heading:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. The storage stability study, which was to be attached with the product chemistry data, was not present. Therefore, a one year storage stability study must be conducted. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and through a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in the trade.

Note: For the Storage Stability study you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate your product.

5. In regards to the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated April 1, 1991, the upper and lower certified limits for water should be reversed. Also please clarify the difference in the amount of water in the product reported in the data submitted and the amount on the CSF.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
