2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 21165-53."
 - b. You cannot make the claim "kills the ticks that may carry Lyme disease" on your label, since the cited product Pyranha Aqueous Equine Formula, EPA Registration No. 21165-34 lacks the efficacy data to support the claim. Refer to our letter of February 19, 1992 regarding Pyranha Aqueous Equine Formula, EPA Registration No. 21165-34.
 - c. Delete "... with pyrethrin" from the product name since this product contains other active ingredients. Statements relating to the composition of the product must be consistent with the ingredient statement.

d. In reference to Product Chemistry:

- 1) The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) states the pH as 6.5 and the data matrix states it as 7.0. Please provide the correct information.
- 2) The CSF states the density as 8.25 pounds/gal. and the matrix states it as 0.814. Please make the necessary correction.

e. Delete the footnote to inert ingredients indicating: "contains petroleum distillates" since the product is a water based formulation.

f. Revise the paragraph under the heading Precautionary Statements as follows:

Humans:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Animals:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with face, eyes, and genitalia. Do not use on puppies or kittens less than six weeks old. Do not use on old, sick, or debilitated animals. Highly sensitive animals may occasionally experience some discomfort from any pesticide. If signs of any adverse reaction occur, discontinue use. If symptoms persist, see your veterinarian.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
