The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyrethrins, Piperonyl butoxide (PBO), and MGK264 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

Use Restrictions

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- Except when applying directly to horses or pets, **DO NOT** apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets either directly or through drift.
- Except when applying directly to horses or pets, **DO NOT** allow adults, children or pets to enter treated area until sprays have dried.
- Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
- **DO NOT** contaminate water, food or feed by use of this product.
- **DO NOT** apply to pets less than 12 weeks old.
- **DO NOT** apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin.
- **DO NOT** apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.
- **DO NOT** use on horses or foals intended for slaughter.
- Consult a veterinarian before applying this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Certain medications can interact with pesticides. Consult a veterinarian before using on medicated animals.
- Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Dogs and Cats: Cover animal's eyes with hand and use a firm fast stroke to get proper spray mist. Apply 1-2 oz. per animal. Spray head, ears and chest until damp. With finger tips, rub into face and around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing with legs last and paying special attention to the footpads (between toes) and underbody areas. Avoid spraying of genital areas. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Follow application with a complete brushing of the animal's hair to remove dead insects. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Reapply treatment as necessary, but do not treat more than once per week.

Puppies and Kittens: Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens or those under 12 weeks old. Treat the same as for dogs and cats. Spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub in with your hands. Follow application with a complete brushing of the animal's hair to remove dead insects. Wash hands thoroughly after use.

Pet's Indoor Sleeping Quarters: For use in companion animal quarters only. Do not broadcast outdoors. Remove animals from quarters before treating premises. Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or lice are present, spray lightly into the air. Reapply treatment as necessary but do not treat more than once per week. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results. Allow all surfaces treated to dry before allowing pets to reoccupy.

Horses: To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and other face flies, apply 1-2 oz. to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Reapply treatment as necessary, but do not treat more than once per week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers and veterinary supplies.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
