# ALGAECIDE



## FIRST AID

### IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call poison control center or physician for treatment advice.

### IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Wash skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes
- Call poison control center or physician for treatment advice.

### IF SWALLOWED:

After a heavy rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load, add one quart of Proline Algaecide to 12,500 gallons of pool water. The above directions must be followed even when the pool is not in use. If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose.

After 72 hours of Proline Algaecide application, if algae is still present, add one quart of Proline Algaecide to 12,500 gallons of pool water. If algae is still visible, repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae. For best results, pool must be cleaned and filled with fresh above-ground water before use. Maintain the pH in the range of 7.2 to 7.6. After addition of Algaecide, run filter for 2 hours to allow for circulation. After adding Proline Algaecide to the pool water, wait approximately 1/2 hour before using pool.

**CONTINUED APPLICATION:** Add one quart of Proline Algaecide to 12,500 gallons of pool water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active.
