Your Amendment Dated October 7, 1993

The amendment (label update and revised CSF) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

b. Note that several of the carbon chain lengths declared in the ingredient statement section were blurry and unreadable.

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



3. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (dated October 7, 1993) is acceptable. Note also that this confidential will supersede all previous Confidential Statement of Formulas.

However note for future reference that the upper certified limit (Block 14a) should be around 41.2% and the lower certified limit (Block 14b) should be around 38.8% for this product.

393 DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Labeling: FOR INITIAL APPLICATION: POOL WATER CHANGE OR VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae. FOR MAINTENANCE: Use one ounce per 5,000 gallons of water each week. After a significant rainfall, add four ounces per 5,000 gallons of water. The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use. BLACK ALGAE ELIMINATOR is compatible with many swimming pool chemicals and when used as directed is not harmful to metal paint, plastic or tile surfaces. BLACK ALGAE ELIMINATOR, when used as directed, will help improve appearance and cleanliness of the pool water and will help inhibit the growth of unsightly algae. BLACK ALGAE ELIMINATOR, when properly stored for prolonged periods of time, will not lose its effectiveness or strength. The correct use-dilution may be added directly to the pool in any spot, or added to the water-circulation equipment. This product is compatible with most chemicals normally used in swimming pools; however, in its concentrated form this chemical should not come in contact with high concentrations of chlorine. Do not mix this product with any other chemicals before adding to the pool. Always add chemicals separately. Do Not Use Water Containing Residue From Use Of This Product To Irrigate Crops Used For Food or Feed.
