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HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation for Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
FOR USE IN SKIMMERS, FLOW-THROUGH & FLOATING FEEDERS. DO NOT ADD DIRECTLY TO POOL. One tablet (approximately 7 oz.) will provide approximately 5.0 ppm of available chlorine in 10,000 gallons of water.

START-UP:

1. Adjust pH of pool water to the 7.2 to 7.6 range with pH increase or pH Decreases as required following label directions.
2. To a clean pool of water which is free of visible algae, and a fast acting chlorinating product to superchlorinate the pool, following label directions. The re-entry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm chlorine residual.
3. Test water for chlorine residual using a reliable test kit.
4. If chlorine residual is below 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million), repeat treatment until proper level is reached.
5. If you pool has not been stabilized previously, add Blue Shield Conditioner and Stabilizer (cyanuric acid) according to label directions. Re-entry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm (parts per million) chlorine residual.

REGULAR CARE:

1. After start-up, add one BLUE SHIELD® JUMBO SLO-POKE® for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. Place tablets in skimmer or dispenser until dissolved.
2. Add one BLUE SHIELD® JUMBO SLO-POKE® for each 10,000 gallons of water each week or as needed to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm as determined by a reliable test kit.
3. Check pool water daily with a reliable test kit and maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm.
4. During extremely hot weather and/or heavy bather loads, additional treatment may be required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage:

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container.

Container Disposal:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
