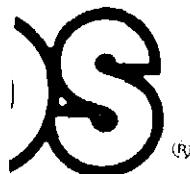

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Blue Shield Slo-Tabs are to be used as a disinfectant and for algae control in pool water. They are long-lasting and are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. In order to obtain its maximum effect, use as follows:

1. Superchlorinate the pool water using a fast acting chlorinating product, following label directions. Do not use pool until the chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm (parts per million).
2. Adjust the cyanuric acid level in the pool water to 35 ppm (parts per million) with Blue Shield's Conditioner and Stabilizer, following directions on the label.
3. Suggested daily dosage is two Blue Shield Slo-Tabs per 9,800 gallons of pool water. Add to floating dispenser, top water skimmer, or automatic chlorinator. This dosage may vary in accordance with temperature, bather load and amount of water flow. Using a reliable test kit as a guide, maintain a 1.0 to 1.5 ppm free chlorine residual. During extreme heat or with heavy bather load, water should be checked every 2 hours. Maintain a pH level of 7.2 to 7.6 for best results. One tablet weighs approximately 1/2 oz. (14 grams). Tablets should not be thrown directly into pool. Not recommended for wader or splasher pools.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

- IF ON SKIN: Brush off excess chemical and flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
- IF IN EYES: Immediately flush with plenty of cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.
- IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air. Get immediate medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat and open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if necessary to dissolve all material before discarding container. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
