1. Transfer the instructions on the front panel to the section under the Directions For Use heading, following the Federal Law Violations Statement.
2. If label space is a limiting factor in addressing comment #1, consider transferring the First Aid section to the front panel. The First Aid statements can be further reduced by revising in the following manner.
 - a) "If in eyes: Flush with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If on skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water."
 - b) Transfer the statements "This product may skin areas," to the precautionary statement section.
3. Add "And Domestic Animals" to "Hazards to Humans."


