Your Submission Dated October 12, 1994

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Delete the box around "For use in all". The box and separation of the phrase implies that this product could be mixed with other items besides paints, stains and coatings.

b. Reinstate "Add 3 oz. M-1 per gallon of paint or stain" in the directions for use. The statement "Add 3 Wt. Ozs. to Each Gallon" on the front panel is not necessary. Please note that the term "Wt." does not make sense in this phrase.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Please note we do not review or stamp accepted Final Printed Labeling but just place it in our correspondence files. Refer to PR Notice 82-2. We reviewed this submission since your cover letter indicated that you wanted a response.
