On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.			
1. Make the following label changes:			
a. Revise the EPA Registration No. to read "EPA Reg. No. 21346-2".

b. As per the product chemistry review dated September 13, 2000, the phrase "contains petroleum distillates" must be placed in a footnote directly below the ingredient statement.

c. As per the acute toxicity review, the signal word currently on the label "DANGER", must be revised to read:

"WARNING      AVISO"

d. The heading "Statement of Practical Treatment" must be changed to "First Aid" and the statements must be revised as follows:

IF IN EYES:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED:

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment.

IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment.

e. As per PR Notice 2001-1, the following hotline information must be added to the label:

"For additional information in case of emergency call toll free (Telephone Number).

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or going for treatment."

- f. As per the RED and acute toxicity review, the PPE must be modified to read:

“Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Mixers and all other handlers must wear:

- long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- socks and shoes
- goggles or face shield, and
- chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material”

- g. As per the RED (Page 196), the registrant must add the following User Safety Requirements for this occupational use product.

“Follow manufacturer’s instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep an wash PPE separately from other laundry”.

- h. As per the REF (Page 197), the registrant must add the following User Safety Recommendations for this occupational use product:

“User Safety Recommendations

Users must wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

Users must remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

Users must remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.”

- i. The following "Environmental Hazards" statement must be added to the label:

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

- j. As per the product chemistry review dated October 4, 2000, the storage and disposal statements must be revised to include the text specified below (including pesticide storage text).

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke."

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### DANGER

If the underlying surface to be coated is first pre-cleaned with a standard bleach solution, wait 36 hours before mixing and applying a paint, stain or coating to which M-1 has been added. M-1 is intended only for protecting the applied thin film of paint, stain or coating itself from mold and mildew attack. It is not intended to protect the surface underneath or near these coatings from mold or mildew attack. M-1 will not render the paint completely immune from mildew attack & growth.
