Subject: M-1 Additive

Amendment Dated November 1, 2004

The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide act as amended to modify the labeling use instructions and to make minor modifications to the precautionary statements is acceptable under the following conditions:

1. Jomaps will inform its retail outlet customers that the M-1 Additive product which is packaged in small size containers (i.e., the 1.5 and 3 oz. pillow packs) must be removed from direct consumer access and placed in the "paint pit" or other such area as paints are mixed and tinted and which are readily accessible only to employees. In its communications with these customers, Jomaps will note that its M-1 Additive product labels will soon bear labeling making it illegal for the product to be sold in its package directly to the consumer. Jomaps will submit copies of its correspondence to its customers on this issue to EPA.
2. Jomaps also will advise its retail outlet customers to be aware of, and comply with, the Personal Protective Equipment statements required to be on the M-1 Additive label. Jomaps will note that its M-1 Additive product labels bear labeling stating that the additive may only be mixed into paints and other coatings by store employees wearing the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (i.e., gloves and eyewear to avoid contact with skin and eyes). Jomaps will submit copies of its correspondence to its customers on this issue to EPA.
3. Jomaps will supply, at shipment, stickers for placement by the paint store employees on the lid of any paint or coating to which M-1 Additive is added in the retail outlet. These stickers will advise the consumer of the need for using a respirator when applying such coatings by sprayer. As indicated in the attachment to this letter, the M-1 Additive

package will bear labeling requiring paint store employees to affix the stickers to the lids of paint cans into which they have added the M-1 Additive. The language on the stickers will read:

"For safety reasons, when applying this paint with a sprayer, wear a dust/mist respirator unless another type of respirator is specified on the paint label."

The number of these stickers supplied by Jomaps to the sales outlet should be equal to the number of gallons of paint which may be treated with the M-1 Additive according to label directions for use. Jomaps will submit documentation of sticker distribution with the initial shipment of product for each of its customers to EPA.

4. Prior to or in those initial shipments, Jomaps will supply each retail sales outlet with an additional number of such stickers equal to the number of gallons of paint which may be treated with the M-1 Additive already on hand in those outlets. Jomaps will submit documentation of sticker distribution for these stocks already in the hands of its customers to EPA.
5. In the event that Jomaps fails to comply with any of the conditions listed above, EPA may cancel this registration using the procedures described in FIFRA § 6(e).

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product may not be added to paint by residential users/consumers. Knead unopened tube with fingers to mix. Cut off corners as marked, squeeze contents into a 1 gallon of paint or other coating. Mix thoroughly into coating. Shake sealed container daily before use. Add 5 squirts per gallon of paint or other coating. Mix thoroughly into coating. Shake container well. Add entire contents into 5 gallon container. Mix thoroughly into coating. Shake well. Pour contents into color canister. Dispense liquid as shown in table "A". Mix thoroughly into coating. If the underlying surface to be coated is first precleaned with a standard bleach, wait 36 hours before applying a paint, or coating to which M-1 has been added.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose in landfill or incineration. If burned stay out of smoke.

To put "3 wt. ozs" of M-1 per gallon of paint or 15wt. ozs. per 5 gallons of paint, "DISPENSE LIQUID" ounces as shown in table "A"
