CRABGRASS and WEED PREVENTER

CAUTION: May injure fine-bladed fescues and bentgrass. DO NOT USE ON DICHONDRA.

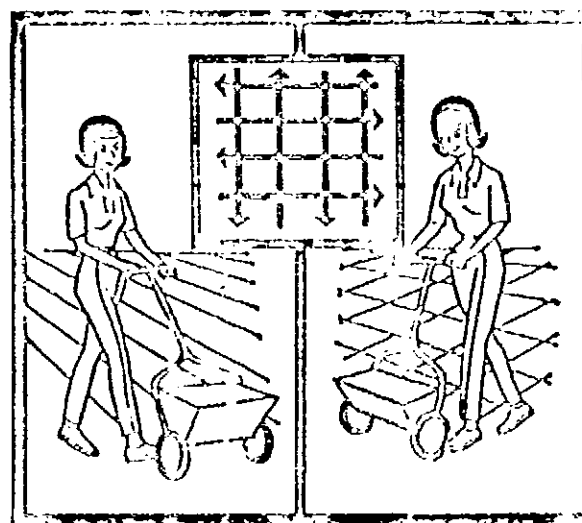
WHEN TO APPLY

New KW Crabgrass and Weed Preventer is a pre-emergence control. It must be applied prior to crabgrass seed germination. The three-way action of KW Weed Preventer gives your lawn the early feeding it needs.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A BETTER LAWN:



1 Determine sq. ft. area to be covered (for example 40' x 50'). One 14 lb. bag may cover 2000 sq. ft. KW Crabgrass and Weed Preventer will not burn when applied at recommended rate.



2 Set spreader as recommended below. Set spreader where spilled material will not fall on lawn. Shake spreader to settle material. Make application in two crisscross coverages as illustrated. Spreader settings below are for crisscross application.



3 Immediately after application, wash New KW Crabgrass and Weed Preventer off the foliage with a medium spray from a hand held nozzle. Sprinkling systems and stationary sprinklers are less satisfactory. Do not water lawn for 24 hours after washing in. Then resume normal watering practice.

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS

Spreading rate may vary with the age, model, and condition of the spreader. Check your spreader by a trial over a known area. (14 lb. bag covers 2000 sq. ft.)

SETTINGS: Above settings are for crisscross application. If your spreader is not labeled above, set spreader opening at lowest setting which gives even flow, usually about 3/8 open. Spread in one direction and then crisscross. Continue crisscrossing until proper amount is applied. Broadcast spreaders are not recommended.
