APPLICATION

WATER-CON is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algae growth, microbiological slime and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 6.13 to 15.32 fluid ounces of WATER-CON per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 48 to 120 parts per million of WATER-CON based on the total weight of water in the system is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 to 15.32 fluid ounces of WATER-CON per 1000 gallons of water (12 to 120 parts per million of WATER-CON) should be employed every 2 to 5 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.
