### GENERAL WEED CONTROL

Winter weeds can be controlled by a fall application. Spring and summer weeds can be controlled by applications made in March. April or May. Treatments may be repeated the year round at regular four month intervals to control weeds and prevent germination of many weed seeds. Do not repeat treatments more than three times a year. On heavy or highly organic soils reduce coverage to 1500 sq. ft for best results. APPLY ONLY TO MATURE DICHONDRA LAWNS (at least one year old.)

### SPOT TREATING

- 1. Apply to weedy area at recommended rate. Avoid over-application in spot-treatments. Use spreader if possible. If discoloration of weeds has not started in three weeks, repeat at recommended rates. Final result at effective rate may take up to four weeks.
- 2. Immediately wash product off the dichondra leaves as indicated in step 3 below.

### **CRABGRASS**







### RESEEDING

Dichondra lawns cannot be reseeded for 120 days after application. Materials that provide effective control of weeds may affect seedings which ger minate after treatment. Proper fertilization and watering will encourage the existing dichondrato fill in the thin or bare spots formerly occupied by weeds


### TREES & SHRUBS:
