CC Supr-San is a cleaner, disinfectant, and sanitizer, designed for industrial and institutional use, such as HOSPITAL, NURSING HOMES, INDUSTRIAL PLANTS, and SCHOOLS where housekeeping will be of prime importance in controlling the hazards of cross infection on environmental inanimate hard surfaces. Hard surfaces sanitization can help in this control, and CC Supr-San can provide the assurance you need in this area, when used as directed.

## Active Ingredients:

n-Alkyl (60% C-14, 30% C-16, 5% C-12, 5% C-18) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides .....	2.25%
n-Alkyl (68% C-12, 32% C-14) dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides .....	2.25%
Sodium Carbonate .....	3.00%

**Keep Out Of Reach Of Children.**

**DANGER:** Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

## USE DIRECTIONS:

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC use dilution confirmation test. For best results use CC Supr-San with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces. If used for the sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or other food contact items, prepare a sanitizing solution of 2.8 ounces Supr-San per 5 gallons of water (200 part per million active quaternaries). Apply to items to be sanitized using cloth or hand mop or immerse items to be sanitized directly in sanitizing solution. After application of CC SUPR-SAN for sanitizing, rinse with potable water. For heavy soil or organic matter a precleaning step is recommended.

## FUNGICIDAL PROPERTIES:

This product will pass the AOAC fungicidal test at the recommended use dilution of 2 ounces per gallon against *trichophyton interdigitale*.
