

Formulated for the control of flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, biting midges, drosophila, fruit flies, ants, roaches and wasps in food processing plants such as wineries, canneries, frozen food plants, dehydrators, meat packing plants, and such food establishments as bakeries, meat markets, restaurants and kitchens.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Inside Use: For flying insects, such as flies, mosquitoes, biting midges, gnats, flying moths, drosophila, fruit flies, and wasps: cover exposed food and utensils and close doors and windows. Use a good sprayer and direct the spray upward so that the spray particles will fill the air, using 2 or 3 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Allow the room to be closed at least 15 minutes for the very best results.

For crawling insects, such as ants and roaches, apply to point of run-off on baseboards,

in all cracks and crevices, underneath sinks, in dark places behind pipes and in places where these insects rest and travel.

For Outside Use: For flying insects indicated above, direct the spray upward to envelop insects while they are in the air, or apply the spray to areas where the insects are resting. For crawling insects apply the spray directly to ant hills, riests and trails. Spray door sills and window wells and other areas where ants enter the building. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Harmful if swallowed. Use in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Food should be removed (r protected during treatment. Remove pets, bird cages, and fish bowls from rooms being sprayed. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Keep container tightly closed.
