COPY: New as well as old redwood, cedar and Douglas fir woods contain natural water-soluble materials which "bleed" or migrate through to the surface. This bleeding is normally reddish brown in fir and cedar and black in redwood. It must be removed with a mild, nonabrasive detergent solution before Natural Wood Preservative is applied.

(Important: Although this product preserves and beautifies your wood, it cannot do so indefinitely. When wood begins to "silver" or darken with age, recoat with Natural Wood Preservative.)

**BOLD:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**COPY:** Stir product thoroughly before using. Apply liberally by brush, roller or spray. Do not apply in direct sunlight or on days when air or surface temperatures are below 50°F (10°C).

**BOLD:** Surface Preparation:

**COPY:** Clean discolored areas with detergent and water to remove dirt. If discoloration is due to resin bleed, remove by sanding. Dark mildew discoloration may be present in new or old wood. It must be removed before applying this product. Scrub surfaces with a solution of 1 part household bleach and 3 parts of water. (Protect eyes and skin while using bleach solution.) Rinse well. Then allow to dry thoroughly. Replace rotted boards and wash surrounding areas with above 1-to-3 solution. (Wood turned dark from mildew must be bleached before application to kill the fungus.) Seal cracks around openings with caulking. Be sure surface is clean and dry. For better adhesion, unweathered areas should be dulled before applying Natural Wood Preservative. Smooth new wood must be sanded to remove the mill glaze.
