DIRECTIONS

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times. Always apply along pool edges to the water.

Pool-side surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use one oz. to four gallons of water for sanitizing or one oz. to two gallons of water for disinfecting. Apply so as to wet surfaces thoroughly with the recommended use solution.
