PRECAUTIONS IN USE

SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL is a ready to use, slow release insecticide. Do not dilute with water, oil, or other materials. Treated surfaces may be cleaned in the usual manner after 36 hours, however, painting over these areas will eliminate the insecticidal effectiveness. **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** insecticide is to be used as a spot treatment only for the control of COCK ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, AND SPIDERS in but not limited to residential and commercial buildings including homes, apartment buildings, hospitals, stores, and warehouses; also trucks, recreational vehicles, mobile homes and boats.

SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL will not stain or mar most clean surfaces, but if doubt exists, treat a small obscure test area prior to complete application. This product may cause blistering of areas freshly painted with lacquers, enamels or other oil base paints unless these finishes are completely cured. Spray a small test area. If blistering has not occurred in 15 minutes it is safe to continue the application.

SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL applied to exposed glass, glazed tile, metal or other nonporous surface may dry leaving a light colored film. If removal is desired re-apply **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL**, lacquer thinner, or other like solvent, let set for two minutes and wipe with dry cloth. Do not apply to clear plastics, i.e. Hi-Fi or pop corn popper covers, dry cleaning garment bags, plastic furniture covers, etc. as solvent may cause pitting.

APPLICATION: Proper application of **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** continuous bands of insecticide which form squares or rectangles must pass to enter the building or reach source of infestation. **NOTE: THESE BANDS MUST BE CONTINUOUS. DO NOT ATTEMPT SHORT CUTS.** Avoid excessive application. Allow adequate ventilation during and for several hours after application. One quart of **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** will treat an average foot home and continue to kill for six months.

Before treating kitchen areas, remove all food, utensils from kitchen cabinets or other storage places. It is advised foods containing fat in sealed containers to prevent them solvent odors. Spray a 3" to 4" band completely around of all shelving, always under, and never on shelves in contact the treated surface. Remove all cabinet and vanity band the three exterior sides. Do not treat drawer interior front panel. Spray a continuous band around undersides and on side panels, paying particular attention to treat around sink. Band exterior cabinet bases and at points join walls. Spray a band of **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** on top of all door casings, along room baseboards and under closets and storage areas. Treat bathroom vanities in kitchen cabinets. Disconnect refrigerator and washer/dryer treat motor housing areas. Allow a few minutes for solvent before re-connecting. Using the pin stream position on any insect **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** into voids, cracks and door facings, around pipes, between false walls and other. If desired, a band may be applied on porches (next to interior exterior window door casings to aid in control of crawling along or up walls, or moving from room to room contact with the insecticide barrier. Insects passing over surfaces will live for several hours, depending on the amount but will die preventing reinfestation for six months.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

APPLICATION Proper application of **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** requires continuous bands of insecticide which form squares or prisons over which insects must pass to enter the building or reach sources of food and water. **NOTE: THESE BANDS MUST BE CONTINUOUS. DO NOT MISS AREAS. DO NOT ATTEMPT SHORT CUTS.** Avoid excessive application and run off. Allow adequate ventilation during and for several hours after application. One quart of **SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL** will treat an average 1,000 square foot home and continue to kill for six months.

Before treating kitchen areas, remove all food, utensils, and containers from kitchen cabinets or other storage places. It is advisable to store foods containing fat in sealed containers to prevent them from absorbing solvent odors. Spray a 3" to 4" band completely around the undersides of all shelving, always under, and never on shelves where food may contact the treated surface. Remove all cabinet and vanity drawers and band the three exterior sides. Do not treat drawer interior or exposed front panel. Spray a continuous band around undersides of counter tops and on side panels, paying particular attention to treating under and around sinks. Band exterior cabinet bases and at points where cabinets join walls. Spray a band of SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL on the flat surface of all door casings, along room baseboards and under all shelving in closets and storage areas. Treat bathroom vanities in same manner as kitchen cabinets. Disconnect refrigerator and washer dryer motors and treat motor housing areas. Allow a few minutes for solvent to evaporate before re-connecting. Using the pin stream position on applicator nozzle, inject SIX MONTHS PEST CONTROL into voids, cracks and crevices, loose door facings, around pipes, between false walls and other nesting areas. If desired, a band may be applied on porches (next to house) and on interior exterior window door casings to aid in control of insects entering from outside doors. The complete treatment insures that insects entering, crawling along or up walls, or moving from room to room will come in contact with the insecticide barrier. Insects passing over these treated surfaces will live for several hours, depending on the amount of contact, but will die preventing reinfestation for six months.
