


Each particle of the Warfarin in this product has been specially coated with a material that reduces detection of the Warfarin by the rodents at the time the bait is consumed. The coating may help assure greater acceptance of the bait in cases where rodent awareness of uncoated Warfarin is responsible for low bait acceptability.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

RATS- Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

MICE- Apply 1 to 2 ounce (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

RATS & MICE- Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. Repeat treatment when infestation recurs. Where continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
