The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

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Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. 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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is for formulating use only as an antifouling ingredient in antifouling coatings, as a fungicide in wood preserving, as an algaecide/mildewcide in roofing materials, and as an antimicrobial additive to ceramic and/or polymeric granules for use in roofing shingles. Formulators are responsible for providing data for supporting their pesticidal product registrations.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U. S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

For use as an antimicrobial additive to ceramic and/or polymeric granules to be used in roofing shingles. This product is to be incorporated into ceramic and/or polymeric granules during the manufacturing process of a masterbatch. The granules are used in the manufacturing process of materials incorporated into final articles. This product provides bacteriostatic, fungistatic, algaestatic, and mildewstatic protection to the final articles identified below. Manufactured products using Purple Copp 97N may not make any public health claims relating to antimicrobial activity without first obtaining an EPA registration for the manufactured products listed below.

Roofing Shingles: For use in the manufacture of ceramic and/or polymeric granules at a maximum concentration of 15% in the granule. The treated granule may not be used at a concentration of greater than 20% in the finished article/roofing shingle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. If spilled, clean up with vacuum or conventional tools. Avoid dusting.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty package into formulating equipment. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of empty package in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Store rinsate for disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of empty package in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
