For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 23.5 to 26.5 fluid ounces of POOL PRIDE ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of POOL PRIDE ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 4.2 to 8.6 fluid ounces of POOL PRIDE ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.
