TO ELIMINATE ALGAE GROWTH

1. Turn off filter pump before application.
2. Brush black algae spots with a brush.
3. Sprinkle Pad Algae Kill directly over the pool walls and floor on which algae appears using appropriate cases of algae growth. Provides approximately 5.0 ppm available chlorine. If necessary, the dosage may be doubled: 1 lb. per 10,000 gallons pool water provides 1.0 ppm available chlorine.
4. Filter pump can be turned on after Pad Algae Kill has been in the pool 8 hours.
5. Brush pool again with stainless steel brush (for masonry and tile) or soft brush for plastic.
6. Do not use pool until chlorine residual falls below 3 ppm.

TO CHLORINATE

1. Check chlorine residual with a reliable test kit. If below 1.0 ppm, broadcast appropriate amount of Pad Algae Kill granular for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. Provides approximately 1.0 ppm available chlorine. Repeat application until a 1.0 - 1.5 ppm residual chlorine is obtained.
2. During extremely hot weather and/or heavy bathing loads, shock dosing may be required. Broadcast of PAD ALGAE KILL will provide 1.0 ppm residual chlorine for every 10,000 gallons of water.
3. Do not measure pH immediately after application and at least once each week with a reliable pool test kit. Adjust pH to 7.2 - 7.8 if necessary by adding a suitable agent such as sodium bicarbonate to decrease pH or soda ash to increase pH. Follow instructions for use on labels of these products.
