The Agency has reviewed the submission referred to above and has the following comments:

1. We will place the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 14, 1993, in the file for this product.
2. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.
  - a. After the active ingredient statement, include the following:  

"INERT INGREDIENTS.....1.6%"
  - b. Under "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL", delete the sentence "Open dumping is prohibited."
  - c. Change the sentence "Not to be reformulated into food or feed uses." to the following:  

"Not to be reformulated into baits to be used for food or feed use."
  - d. Under "STORAGE:", insert the following statement as the first sentence:  

"Store in a locked storage area, in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets."

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

DANGER**

Convulsive Poison. Poisonous if Swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Do not contaminate feed and food-stuffs. Keep away from children, pets and domestic animals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Clean clothing should be used daily.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If swallowed** — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately if less than ten (10) minutes have passed since the poison was taken, give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep him warm and quiet. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled** — Remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

**If on skin** — Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**If in eyes** — Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Administer 100% OXYGEN by positive pressure to provide as much pulmonary gas exchange as possible, despite seizures.

Administer ANTI-CONVULSANT DRUGS intravenously to control convulsions. CAUTION: It may be difficult or impossible to stop the seizure activity without stopping respiration. Be prepared to maintain pulmonary ventilation mechanically. Tracheostomy may be necessary if seizures are prolonged.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**STORAGE:** If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spills, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Sweep on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or residue is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. 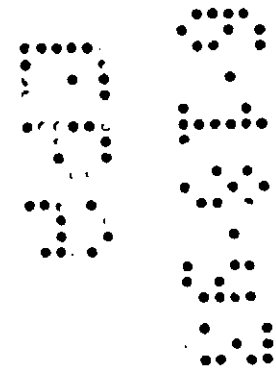
