


The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.</p> <p>Based upon your submission of May 5, 2000, and your prior responses to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) document issued for Strychnine, EPA has reregistered the product identified above. This action is taken under the authority of §4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.</p> <p>The label that you submitted on May 5, 2000, is acceptable, provided that you make the changes indicated in this letter. The "100% OXYGEN" sentence must be restored to the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" text and the two paragraphs should be lettered. We apologize for having inadvertently omitted that paragraph from the template that we provided you with our letter of March 27, 2000. IF SWALLOWED : CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
