DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use in accordance with Federal Law to use this product as a fumigant throughout the area to be treated. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Use additional safety for specific rooms as follows: See back of can for details.

IMPORTANT:

Always fogger in order of rooms or areas being treated. Place newspaper under fogger unit and in those areas that cannot be reached by normal means. Close doors and windows. Remove pets and people or remove both birds. Cover or remove exposed foods and dishes. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put off all open flames except pilot lights. Place or shut off light away from pilot light. Auto or other lights which remain. Place top of all doors from both sides and open. To start fogging action, pull plunger, hold on valve about 10 seconds. Set on sprayer position and leave the fogging at work. Leave unattended for at least 2 hours. Open doors and windows and thoroughly ventilate or at least 1 hour. Do not allow children or pets to be in or sleep in treated areas until at least 2 hours following treatment. Substitute only certain areas applicable to specific life forms. It would require four applicators of synthetic life, newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around the area of activity. Do not use with freshly washed floors, allow floor to become harder. Some plastics may be affected. Rubbed or other plastic should apply as appropriate. Wash walls, remove items.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not compress, pierce, heat, or hold by flame or other heat source. Do not use empty container. Empty container and put in trash collection.
